RING 1 : 10am Start Indoors

CLASS 1 Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 30 cms No Spreads

CLASS 2 Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 40 cms

NOTE Riders who compete in Ring 1 may only ride in Class 3 in Ring 2

RING 2 : Outdoors This ring will start at the conclusion of ring 1

Qualifiers for Championship of GB

CLASS 3 10 years and under, may be led, Approx 45 cms

CLASS 4 No riders that have ridden in ring 1 may compete in class 4-11

14 years and under, Approx 55 cms

CLASS 5 Novice, combination not to have won an open jumping class. Approx 60 cms

CLASS 6 Novice combination not have won £10 Show Jumping Approx 65 cms

Open. Approx 70 cms

RING 3 : 11.00am outdoors

Qualifer for South West Pony Association Championships

NQ Class 12 - Best Turn Out –May be led- Open

Q Class 13 - Best lead rein pony SWPA (K abc)

NQ Class 14 - Pony Club Pony (not exceeding 15hh)

To be judged on suitability for pony club activities. Will be asked to jump a small course.

Q Class 15 – Ridden Mountain & Moorland SWPA (M1 N)

Need not be registered, but must be true to type.

NQ Class 16 - Family Horse or Pony

To be judged on manners and suitability for more than one family member.

Class may be split if sufficient entries. May be asked to jump

Q Class 17 - Working Hunter Horse / Pony SWPA (L 234)

Class may be split into relevant height categories if sufficient entries.

Q Class 18 – Not before 1.30pm.

Veteran Horse or Pony, Over 15 years, SWPA (V1)

Q Class 19 – Coloured Horse or Pony SWPA (D1)

To include Palomino, Spotted & dun

Q Class 20 Retrained Racehorse SWPA (X1)

NQ Class 21 - Riding Club Horse or Pony

To be judged on suitability for riding club activities. Will be asked to jump a small course.

Q Class 22 - Best Cob SWPA (C 1,2)

Class 23 Championship 1st and 2nd from each class.
