RING 1 : 10am Start Indoors

Combination in first two classes, may not compete beyond class 4

CLASS 1

Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 35 cms No Spreads or fillers

CLASS 2

Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 40 cms no spreads or fillers

Combinations in classes,3 and 4 may not compete beyond class 7

CLASS 3

Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 45 cms No fillers.

CLASS 4

Mini Jumping Open may be led or assisted Approx 50 cms

CLASS 5

Open may be assisted Approx 55 cms

CLASS 6

Open Parker and Parker Novice Championship apx 60 cms
No lead or assisted

All Open classes are Wales and West qualifiers

Classes 6,7,8 Parker & Parker Championship

Class 9,10,11 Caroline Cook Open jumping Championship

Novice, must not have won £10 Show Jumping.

RING 2 : 11am Start Outside, in the event of unsuitable weather all classes will be moved indoors.

Clear round jumping. (Not schooling)

The fences will be raised every 30 mins, you will not be allowed to adjust or alter the fences in the ring, after two attempts at each fence you will move to the next fence.

Ring 2 Starting at the conclusion of Class 6

Class 7: Parker and Parker Open Novice approx 60cms

Class 8: Parker and Parker Open Novice approx 65cms

Class 9: Caroline Cook Open approx 70cms

Class 10: Caroline Cook Open approx 80cms

Class 11: Caroline Cook Open approx 90cms

This class will be run over 3 rounds

Ring 3 Cross Country Clear round

This course is in a six acre field, suitable for led or assisted or those looking to gain experience.

This will be a 20 fence course, the base course is approx. 55-60 cms, many of the fences have bigger options up to 75cms at each numbered fence the rider may chose the marked fence they wish to jump.

After two attempts at each fence you will move to the next fence
